

JUNE 2010 Final Exam and Regents Exams

On June 10, 11, and 14th ND-BG local school exams will be given. Regent exams are from the 15th through the 22nd. Students who have an exam or a Regents review class need to be in school at the designated times assigned by their teacher. All regularly scheduled classes end on Wednesday June 09, 2010. On the 9th the students will not have Period 9. At the end of Period 8 students in grades 6-11 will go to their homeroom; they will receive instructions regarding locker clean up.

- **Please URGE your child to begin clearing their lockers of old lunches, items of clothing, etc. prior to June 09th to help reduce the amount they are taking home that day.**

1. **Burnt Hills/Ballston Spa, Guilderland, Scotia/Glenville, and Mohonasen School Districts** will provide a midday pick-up during school exams (June 10, 11, & 14). These districts will also provide a morning and end of the day run as well.

- **All other districts will only be providing a morning and end of the day pick-up for June 10, 11, and 14th.**
- **PLEASE LET US KNOW ASAP IF YOU'RE CHILD IS GOING TO NEED BUS TRANSPORTATION. IF YOU DO NOT NOTIFY US THEN A BUS WILL NOT BE CONTACTED.**
- **Students who are taking Regent exams starting June 15th only need to be in school for the exam.**
 - **All School districts will provide a morning drop-off and end of the day pick-up.**
 - **For exams only in the afternoon parents/guardians will need to provide for transportation for the designated exam time.**

2. On or before June 10 individual teachers will inform their classes of the dates and times for any Regents or Spanish Grade 8 Proficiency review classes.

3. Students' books from their home school districts **MUST** be returned on or before the date each school district specifies. If not, in September students will not be issued books for the 2009-2010 academic years. Regarding the textbook return dates -----school districts notify parents via mail or in the newspaper or you may need to phone them. Books must be returned to the district that issued the books.

If a subject is NOT noted on the SCHOOL EXAM SHEETS and it is NOT noted on the REGENTS EXAM SHEET, it is either given during class time or the teacher has assigned a project as the final exam.











**The High School students will be taking 2 exams on 10, 11, and 14th: 8:30-10:30 & 12-2.
