#### **Population**

The student body is comprised of 250 students in grades 6 - 12 with a student to teacher ratio of 12 : 1.

#### Academics

Our program follows the guidelines set forth by the New York State Board of Regents. Students can receive college credit while in high school through the UHS, CHS and AP programs. The graduating class of 2016 (40 students) received over <u>8.9 million dollars</u> in scholarships and grants.

#### **Christian Service**

Christian Service is an integral part of our curriculum. All ND-BG students have a service requirement as part of the religion curriculum. Students who attend ND-BG from grades 6-12 will perform over 100 hours of service to their community.
